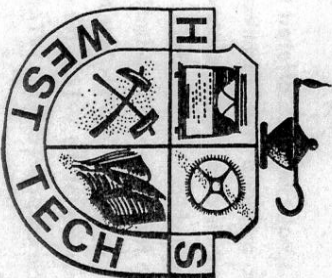

West Tech Alumni Scholarship Program

The West Tech Alumni Association

The WTAA was established in 1982 and incorporated in 1996. An important part of the WTAA is the promotion of excellence in education through the granting of scholarships to WTAA alumni and their descendants.

Scholarships

The WTAA scholarships are offered to anyone who attended West Technical High School, and their children, grand-children, or great-grandchildren. This offer is also extended to former faculty and staff of West Tech. The West Tech sponsor must be a current member of the WTAA, for a student to be considered for a WTAA Scholarship.

The WTAA Scholarship Committee reviews each application and bases the awarding of scholarship funds on academic performance and financial needs.

Scholarships are awarded for academic, vocational, and technical programs.

Applying for a Scholarship

Applications

Fill out the Application Form and send it to the WTAA. Make sure high schools, colleges, universities, and technical or vocational institutions send us your transcripts.

Autobiographical sketch

This is a 250 to 500-word statement that includes telling the committee about your background, what you've done -- including extracurricular activities -- and explaining your academic and career goals.

Transcripts

An official grade transcript is required for your application to be considered. Please have the institution you are attending send your official grade transcript to the WTAA, 2201 West 93rd Street, Room 101, Cleveland Ohio 44102-3780. If you have not been involved in post high school educational or vocational/technical program before, we will need your high school transcripts.

Letters of Recommendation

Have three letters of recommendation sent to the WTAA. At least one letter should be from an academic advisor, dean, or department chair. A letter from your employer, if you are employed, and a personal recommendation from someone other than a family member.

Confidentiality

All records are confidential and no information will be released without your expressed written permission. We request your grades be sent to us following your first semester, to keep our files current.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS

Have your completed application and transcript to the WTAA by April 15 of each year.

Starting with the 2012-13 school year, the WTAA criteria will be one scholarship per family, per year.

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
